



SRILA PRABHUPAD AT A GLANCE

(Srila Bhakti Siddhanta Sarasvati Gosvami Prabhupad)



Birth	: Born on 6th February 1874 at Narayan Chata (Presently Sri Chaitanya Gaudiya Math) Grand Road, Puri.
Parents	: Srila Bhaktivinode Thakur & Bhagawati Devi.
Guru (Spiritual Master)	: Srila Gaurkishore Das Babaji Maharaj.
Founder	: Founded Sri Gaudiya Math & Gaudiya Mission in 1918 & from Sri Mayapur Dham Srila Prabhupad established 64 branches in India & 3 branches abroad i.e. Burma, Germany & England.
Honoured	: Srila Bhakti Siddhanta Sarasvati Gosvami Prabhupad was conferred the title of 'SRILA PRABHUPAD' in 1924 on the occasion of his first Vyasa Puja Celebration at Mayapur.
Renowned Reformist	: Reformed pure Gaudiya Vaishnavism (Sudha Sanatan Dharma) by opposing all other Non-Vedic thoughts.
Chief Editor	: Dainik Nadia Prakash (Daily Bengali Newspaper), Gaudiya (Fortnightly Bengali Magazine), Bhagawat (Hindi Monthly Magazine), Kirtan (Assamese Monthly Magazine), Paramarthi (Odia Monthly Magazine), The Harmonist (English Monthly Magazine).
Pioneer	: He was the Pioneer of World Hare Krishna Movement.
Prabhupad and his disciples established	: Approximately 5000 Vaishnav Maths world wide.
Preacher	: He was a renowned speaker and preacher of pure tanets of Lord Sri Chaitanya Mahaprabhu.
Great Acharya	: Successor Acharya in Brahma Madhva Gaudiya Sampradaya.
Great Philosopher	: He was considered as a unique Gaudiya Vaishnava Philosopher of his era.
Foreign Preacher	: He was the first Acharya to send massengers (Spd. B. P. Thirth Maharaj, Spd. B. H. Bon Maharaj & Sri Samvidananda Das) and established Hindu temples in European countries in 1933 and influenced them to adopt the philosophy. This had happened for the first time in world history.
Eminent Disciples	: Succeeding Acharyas of Gaudiya Mission, Founder of Sri Chaitanya Research Institute, Founder of Sri Chaitanya Gaudiya Math, Founder of Bhakti Vedanta Trust, Founder of ISKCON and many others disciples.

Beloved of Sri Jagannath	:	At the age of 6 months the chariot of Lord Jagannath waited for 3 days in Puri to bless Srila Prabhupad and blessed him with prasadi garland.
Great Ascetic	:	Chanted daily 3 lakh Harinam continuously for 9 years 4 months to meet up the target of 100 crores Harinam and was a sincere, dedicated, Brahmachary and Sanyasi.
Restart	:	Restarted Sri Nabadwip Dham Parikrama on 29th February 1920.
Re-Establish	:	Re-established Vishwa-Vaishnav Rajsabha on 5 th February, 1919.
Outstanding Publisher and Writer	:	He wrote and publish more than 1000 monograph & 100 books on pure spirituality.
Revivalist & Lion-Guru	:	He never compromised with impure devotional thoughts or Non-Vedic Philosophy.
Famous Astronomer	:	Awarded as “Siddhanta Saraswati” in astronomy and wrote books “Surya Siddhanta” and “Siddhanta Shiromany Panjika” on astrology at an early age.
Promoter	:	Promoted Spiritual Exhibitions World - wide.
Creator	:	The pioneer of the world’s largest Krishna Consciousness family.
Spiritual Guider of	:	Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose, Madan Mohan Malviya, Chakravarti Rajgopalacharya and many more eminent personalities.
God Realized Soul	:	God appeared with his associates to give “Darshan” to Srila Prabhupad in the year 1914 in Mayapur.
Educational Institutions	:	Srila Prabhupad founded ‘Thakur Bhaktivinode Institute’, ‘Para-Vidyapeeth’, ‘Bhagavat Pathshala’ & ‘Bhaktivinode research Institue’ for spreading Vedic knowldege.
Re-Connector	:	Strongest reconector of modern science & spiritual science of his era.
The first beginner	:	Srila Prabhupad first started Brajmondal Parikrama on foot with mass devotees in the year 1932 (for 32 Days) in Vrindavan.
Established	:	On 9th October 1935 Srila Prabhupad established “Brajdhama Pracharini Sabha”.
Booster	:	Srila Prabhupad boosted up Vedic living system as “Daiva-Varnashram Dharma” i.e. Training system for God realization. It was a great revolution in the modern society.
Disappearance	:	He breathed his last on 1st January 1937 at Sri Gaudiya Math, Bagbazar, Calcutta, the Headquarter of Gaudiya Mission.
